

Call for Oncological Pathology Mystery Slide Case Submissions for the 2022: ECVP/ESVP Annual Meeting in Athens, Greece. Saturday 10th of September Session.

Dear attendees,

A mystery slide session will be organized Saturday September 10th at the ECVP/ESVP Congress in Athens. This year the theme will focus on Oncology. If you have a fun, unusual, complex, challenging case or a case with outstanding clinical repercussion, please consider a submission as a mystery case. We are especially looking for cases where novel therapeutic approaches or specific outcomes related to prognostic variables could be included. True “unsolved mysteries” are highly encouraged for the sake of a good discussion.

Please send your submissions to session chairs Prof. Laura Peña and Prof. Paola Roccabianca with the subject line “(Your name) Oncology Session Mystery Slide Case Submission” and attach the following:

A single pdf document consisting of a summary of the case (250 words maximum) including title, your name, institution, and contact information (e.mail address mandatory), signalment, short history, summary of representative gross and microscopic findings, any additional supporting data, and no more than five good quality images (histo +/- gross +/- special stains including histochemistry and immunohistochemistry and any other useful technique such as clonality, EM etc.) that are representative of the lesion.

Deadline for submissions is June 30th, 2022. Submission must be sent to Prof. Laura Peña laurape@vet.ucm.es and Prof. Paola Roccabianca paola.roccabianca@unimi.it.

Decisions on cases chosen for the session will be made no later than July 15th and submitters will be informed by e.mail.

If the case is chosen, the submitter must be able to present the case at the 2022 ECVP/ESVP Annual Meeting in Athens on September 10th, and must be able to send a minimum of 2 H&E-stained glass slides for scanning by 30th of July at the following address:
