Dr. Lewis received her DVM from Texas A&M University in 1986. She received her residency training at the Animal Medical Center and Wildlife Conservation Society (Bronx Zoo). She became a diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Pathologists in 1991. She received her PhD in Experimental Pathology from the Ohio State University studying Simian Immunodeficiency Virus pathogenesis. She has been a veterinary pathologist at the Oregon National Primate Research Center at the Oregon Health and Science University since 1999, specializing in support of translational models of human disease in nonhuman primates and spontaneous disease of macaques. As a veterinary pathologist and head of the Pathology Services Unit at the Oregon National Primate Research Center, she is responsible for coordination of administrative functions of the unit, performing gross morbid and microscopic examination of tissues in support of animal disease diagnosis and surveillance, contributing professional expertise and consultation to ONPRC research projects, and participating in collaborative research.
